

WHAT'S GOING ON? Two Key Things Happening in the Text:



2. Jesus **HEALS** an entire town. (Verses 32-34)

WHAT IT ALL BOILS DOWN TO One Key Truth About Jesus:

→ Jesus was a TIRELESS and SYMPATHETIC Servant, and he STILL IS.

WHAT WE SHOULDN'T MISS Three Key Life Lessons:

- 1. Service is the **TELLTALE SIGN** of someone who's been **TOUCHED** by the Servant.
- 2. It's never a wrong time to **BRING** someone to **JESUS' DOOR**.
- 3. Be careful to **REMEMBER** the spiritual **IMPLICATIONS** of Jesus' compassion and service.
