### WHAT WE SHOULDN'T MISS

#### *Three Key Life Lessons:*

1. One of the greatest struggles for Christians is between God's **GREATER PLAN** and **OUR DESIRES**.
2. The wonderful thing about prayer is that it **CONNECTS** you with God **ANYWHERE** you are.
3. We will never affect others as Christ did unless there is **CONTACT** and **IDENTIFICATION**.

### Getting Started

1. On Sunday, we saw how the kingdom of God moved forward as Jesus prayed, preached, and touched lives. Why are these three activities still important for the advancement of God's kingdom today?

### Digging Deeper

2. In Mark 1:35, we noticed Jesus going "off to a solitary place, where he prayed." Why do you think Jesus went off to a solitary place? How does this influence your own prayer life?
3. On one occasion, Jesus was asked by one of his disciples to teach them how to pray. Jesus answered, "When you pray, say 'Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. And lead us not into temptation'" (Luke 11:2-4). What are some things you can notice about Jesus' example prayer? What do your observations teach you about prayer?
4. On Sunday, we noticed that prayer had a critical role in Jesus' preaching and healing ministries. What does this teach you about the relationship between prayer and ministry today?

### Driving It Home

5. One of the great lessons from Sunday's text is that Jesus didn't just pray, he also dealt with people engulfed in brokenness. How does the way Jesus dealt with people *then* influence how you deal with people *today*?
6. After listening to Sunday's sermon and walking through this study, what are you feeling led to pray for? Spend some time with God in prayer.
