When History Repeats Itself

Hosea 10:9-15

What Happened at Gibeah?

(Verses 9-10; Judges 19-20)

The twelve tribes of Israel almost **BECAME** eleven, and the story is about to be **REPEATED**.

What's Happening in Israel?

- 1. Gibeah-like WICKEDNESS continues to be planted. (Verse 13)
- 2. Like Gibeah, Israel will now reap **DEVASTATION**. (Verses 11, 14-15)

THE INVITATION → "**BREAK UP** your unplowed ground." (Verse 12)

Planting Righteousness Today

1. Make a committed decision to **BREAK UP** any **HARDENED** ground in your heart.

REMEMBER -> Breaking up unplowed ground is **HARD** work, but it's **NECESSARY** for good soil.

2. Continually **PLANT** the gospel into your **HEART** and **MIND**.

REMEMBER -> Even good soil won't **PRODUCE** anything if you aren't **PLANTING** anything.

3. Be careful not to fall into the trap of **LEGALISM**.

REMEMBER → Legalism says, "I AM righteous;" faith says, "JESUS is my righteousness."
