## A History Lesson Part 1

Hosea 11:12-12:6

### Learning from Jacob

- 1. Jacob was a **GRASPER** and a **DECEIVER**, and so were his **DESCENDANTS**. (11:12; 12:1, 3a)
- 2. God had a charge against Jacob, but Jacob **BEGGED** God for his **GRACE**. (12:2, 3b-6)

**THE LESSON**  $\rightarrow$  You are who you are **ENTIRELY** by God's **GRACE**.
